HOMESTEAD CUSTOM CABINETRY CARE AND CLEANING SUGGESTIONS

All fine furniture deserves gentle care and your Homestead Cabinetry is no exception.

Your Homestead cabinetry is finished with durable industrial coatings, ensuring years of lasting beauty for you to enjoy. We are proud of the fine cabinetry that we create and we want to help you maintain its beauty, richness, and elegance. Our finishes are easy to maintain and they all have a high degree of resistance to normal household products.

For everyday cleaning, slightly dampen a soft, clean, non-abrasive cloth and wipe the surface of the cabinetry and then immediately dry with a soft cloth. For a more thorough cleaning, use an ounce of Spic and Span, or similar mild detergent, per gallon of warm water. Never use a wet cloth that allows water to run down the cabinetry and always wipe the area dry with a soft cloth. Harsh detergents, ammonia solutions, and cleaners with abrasives should never be used on fine cabinetry. These cleaning agents may cause scratching, marring, discoloration and dulling of the finish.

We do not recommend using furniture polishes and waxes as they can alter the sheen level and may leave a dust attracting film on the surface. Polishes may also cause a blotchy or irregular appearance.

Do not use a dishcloth for cleaning. It could contain remnants of grease, food particles or detergents.

The areas around the sink, dishwasher, range, oven and trash units are most susceptible to moisture and water damage. Keep these areas clean and dry.

Remove spills immediately and avoid lengthy exposure to direct sunlight, high humidity or dry environments.

Following these suggestions will help to keep your Homestead cabinetry beautiful for years to come.
